SEGUIN - **Explore Seguin** - This quiet burg features a Catholic church, cemetery, grain elevator and a gas station. From Hoxie, 8 1/2 miles west on U.S. 24, three miles south on K-188.

HOXIE - Hoxie Municipal Golf Course, 825 W Rd 5S - Bring your clubs and play on this 9-hole, grass green course. Greens fee, \$25. Cart rental available.

HOXIE - Sheridan County Courthouse, 925 9th - 1918 Classical Eclecticism structure. Closed Saturday but if you arrive early on Friday stop in to see beautiful tiles and stained glass. Drive by only on Saturday.

9 AM 11 AM **SELDEN - Public Library,** 109 S Kansas - Small-town libraries are more than book havens — they're community lifelines. Stop by and experience the heart of the community.
