### **Rock Creek Lake & Falls, 195th St, Fort Scott / GPS coordinates: 37.816186, -94.756973 - Thur-Sun, daylight hours**

Located on the Marmaton River, and surrounded by deep woods, Rock Creek serves as a habitat for wildlife and a quiet haven for fishermen, canoeists and campers. From S. National Ave., drive west on 18th St for approximately 2.4 miles. The street name will change to Kansas Road and after an unpaved stretch, will turn south becoming 195th Street, which runs along the east side of Rock Creek Lake. Pull into the park at the north end of Rock Creek Lake and follow the narrow gravel road across the dam to the turn around next to the falls. Warning! There is only room for one car on the narrow gravel road. Please watch carefully for other cars, or walk the short distance to the falls.

### **Sale Barn Café, 2131 Maple Rd, Fort Scott - 620.223.4600 - Fri-Sat, see description**

Located at the Fort Scott Livestock Market, the café is known for their hearty portions and excellent pie. Plus, if you've never experienced a livestock auction, this is a good time to see one. Friday 7am-2pm and Saturday 6am-4pm or until the sale is over.
