The workshop will allow participants to create a design in resin bonded sand that will be cast into iron during an Iron Pour event on Saturday, May 6. People who are interested in this event can opt to have their tile mailed to them at the cost of shipping or pick up the tile on Sunday, May 7 at 10 am. No pre-registration required, but tiles will be sold on a first come, first serve basis. Fee is \$35 per tile, with the option of shipping if needed. Maximum number of participants is limited to 30.
- SATURDAY, 10:30am-6:30pm: Iron Pour Spirit Sculpture Gardens, 116 N Main, Smith Center. The Cast Iron Pour is a spectacle to behold! Watch sculptors from around the area and state play with liquid metal like you've never seen before. This is a come and go event but you don't want to miss the sight of red hot metal being poured into the scratch blocks our visitors made when the furnace goes full blast at 6pm.
